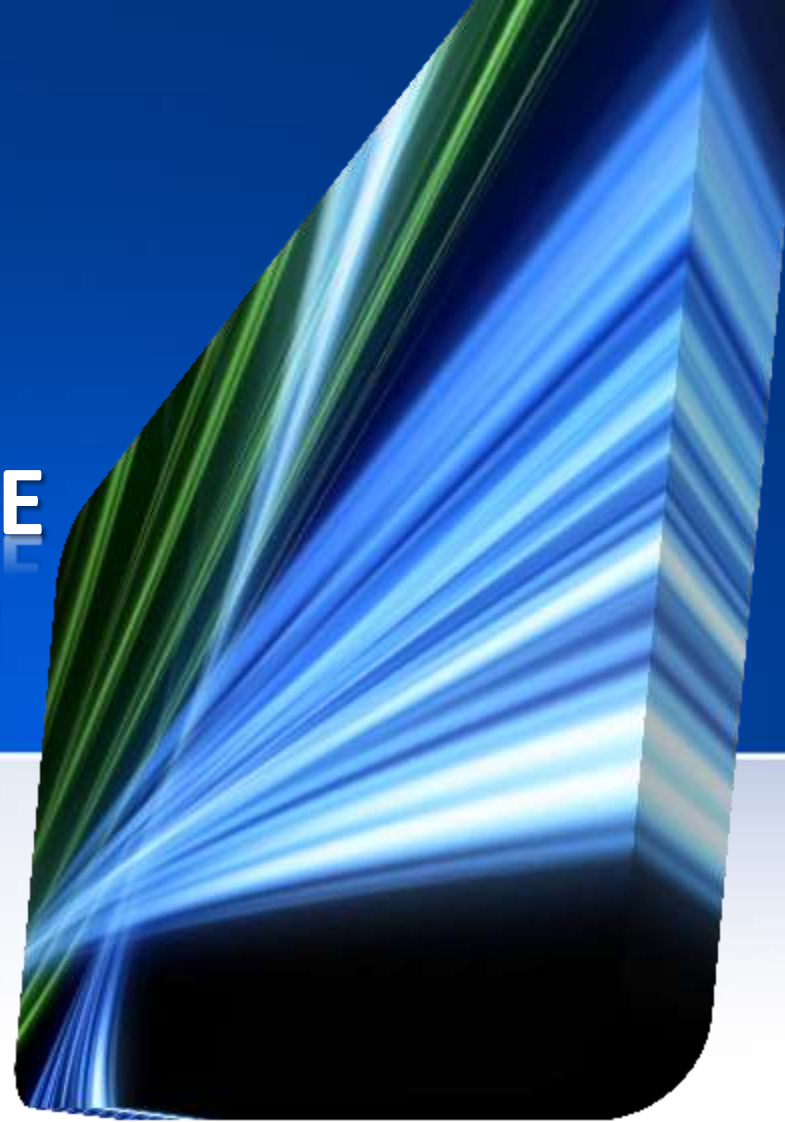

THE PROCESSES OF APOSTILLE



- ❑ **By now, the processes of appostille is carried out by,**
- ✓ Ministry of Justice (legal documents)
- ✓ Ministry of Interior (for administrative documents)

THE ALTERNATIVES IN PRACTICE



- The Convention suggests, e-register to be carried out by a single body.
- If authorized, Turkish Post PTT is eager to render e-apostille service in Turkey.

THE ALTERNATIVES IN PRACTICE



- ❑ A database of the e-Apostilles generated by The Justice and Interior Ministeries may be formed within PTT and provide access to the authority.

E-APOSTIILE... BUT WHY?



- ✓ It's possible to accelerate the processes of apostilles issued by authorized institutes by integrating with the relevant..
- ✓ Electronically created documents delivered to PTT, may be aproved, e-apostilled and then delivered to the citizens.

MANUAL PROCESS



- ❑ to apostille a document manually, may take long and cost much, depending on the document type...
 - Creation of document by Competant Authority
 - Apostilization by Competant Authority
 - delivery of the document to the recipients

E - APOSTILLE PROCESS



To produce e-apostille

- Creation of electronic document by Competant Authority
- To e-apostille an electronic document,
- delivery of the e-apostille and electronic document to the recipients

To verify an e-apostille

- If needed, the e-apostille processes may be verified by the recepiant.

E – APOSTILLE PROCESS



- E-apostilizing
 - Documents created with e-signature
 - Registered E-mail documents
 - Documents given by e-government
 - Digitized hard copy documents
